In November 2016, Nicola was diagnosed with leukemia at just 16 months old. She and her family were airlifted to Vancouver from their home on Vancouver Island, and found out that they would not be going home for months.

At the House, Nicola's family found a community of support made up of staff, volunteers, and other families who understood exactly what they were going through and who could help each other cope.

Staying at the House also meant that Nicola's older brother and sister could stay with her for the holidays and the family could celebrate together. "Ronald McDonald House includes everybody. They take care of the whole family, not just the patient," says dad Mike.
