



# Home For Dinner

## FAQ

### 1. I want to host a Home for Dinner event. Where do I start?

The first place to start is to check out our "How To" document. This document will provide you with all the information needed to get started.

### 2. Can I get a tax receipt for the supplies I purchased to host a dinner?

Yes, you are eligible for a tax receipt for the food or other administrative expenses incurred by hosting a dinner. Eligible expenses include: food, beverages, alcohol, décor or rentals. We will receipt the pre-tax amount for purchases over \$20.

To be eligible for a tax receipt, we require:

1. The **original** receipt(s) with any items that are NOT for the dinner clearly identified
2. A completed Home for Dinner Tax Receipt Request Form available at [www.rmhbc.ca/home-for-dinner](http://www.rmhbc.ca/home-for-dinner). Your personal information - name, address, phone and email - must be provided in full.

Tax receipt requests must be submitted within one month of your dinner and can be submitted in-person or mailed to:

Tax receipts will be issued by RMH BC once net funds are remitted with all the necessary information.

### 3. Can I get a tax receipt if I host a dinner at a restaurant and pay the bill for all my guests?

Yes, you are eligible for a tax receipt for a restaurant bill. Eligible expenses include food, beverages and alcohol. We will receipt the pre-tax amount for purchases over \$20.

To be eligible for a tax receipt, we require:

1. The **original** receipt(s) with any items that are NOT for the dinner clearly identified
2. A completed Home for Dinner Tax Receipt Request Form available at [www.rmhbc.ca/home-for-dinner](http://www.rmhbc.ca/home-for-dinner). Your personal information – name, address, phone and email – must be provided in full.

Tax receipt requests must be submitted within one month of your dinner and can be submitted in-person or mailed to:

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Tax receipts will be issued by RMH BC once net funds are remitted with all the necessary information.

### 4. Can my guests get a tax receipt for the donation they make at my event?

If the Host of an event submits the donations on behalf of attendees, tax receipts will be issued by RMH BC once net funds are remitted with a list of donor names, addresses and amounts of individual donations. If the donations are made directly online via the Host's fundraising page, tax receipts will be automatically issued to donors.

### 5. How do I submit my donations?

Any donations collected through your online Home for Dinner fundraising page will go directly to RMH BC. Any cash or cheque donations collected by the Host can be submitted in person at RMH BC located on the property of BC Children's Hospital (4567 Heather Street) during regular business hours: Monday to Friday, 9:00am – 5:00pm. Cheque donations made payable to Ronald McDonald House BC can be mailed to the address below. Please do not mail cash donations.
